

Getting to the Fairmont Hotel:

Our best advice is - don't get a rental car unless it is absolutely unnecessary. Parking is expensive and navigating in the city is difficult and not worth the headache. Instead, plan to get a muni pass and use the world-famous cable car system! You can purchase tickets at the Cable Car Ticket Booth on Market at Powell or the Montgomery Metro Station on Market at Montgomery. Taxis are also an option.

There are several van services that are located in a group on the airport's second level -- one floor above the baggage claim at San Francisco International Airport (SFO). You can easily go directly there after getting your luggage, and will have no trouble finding a van to bring you into the city even without calling ahead.

Lorrie's Airport Service and **SuperShuttle San Francisco** are two of the more popular van services. All major credit cards are accepted.

Cost to share is approximately \$17 pp (plus tip).

If you opt to use a taxi, cost will be closer to \$48, plus tip.
